


GULF MARINE LIFE CROSSWORD

ACROSS ANSWERS

- 1. AMBERJACK** - A large, powerful fish found in deeper Gulf waters, popular with offshore anglers for their fighting ability.
- 4. POD** - A group of dolphins that travel, hunt, and socialize together, usually consisting of related individuals.
- 6. FLUKE** - The horizontal tail fin of a dolphin or whale, used for propulsion through the water.
- 8. ECHOLOCATION** - The biological sonar system dolphins use to navigate and hunt by producing clicks and interpreting the echoes.
- 10. MULLET** - A common bait fish in the Gulf, important food source for dolphins, larger fish, and seabirds.
- 11. TARPON** - Large, silvery fish known for their spectacular jumping ability when hooked, called the "silver king."
- 12. MIGRATION** - The seasonal movement of animals between different areas, often following food sources or breeding cycles.

- 2. REDDRUM** - Also called redfish, a popular game fish found in Gulf shallow waters and marshes.
- 3. SHEEPSHEAD** - A fish species common around jetties and pilings, known for their human-like teeth, adapted for crushing barnacles.
- 5. KINGFISH** - Also known as king mackerel, a popular sport fish in the Gulf known for speed and sharp teeth.
- 7. REDSNAPPER** - A prized deep-water fish species in the Gulf, subject to strict fishing regulations for conservation.
- 9. BAITFISH** - Small fish (like sardines, anchovies, and menhaden) that serve as food sources for larger fish, dolphins, and seabirds.
